In exercise of the powers conferred by UGC (Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging in Technical Institutions, Universities including Deemed to be Universities imparting Technical Education) Regulation 2009, an Anti-Ragging Committee consisting of the following is constituted at The Oxford College Of Science for preventing, curbing, and combatting any incidence of ragging in the college and hostels attached thereto

The procedure prescribed in the UGC Regulations 2009 shall be adopted and enforced for prevention of ragging of the students. The committees shall meet as frequently as possible at least once in 2 months or immediately on receipt of a complaint to consider the complaint lodged by the students and initiate such remedial action as is deemed necessary to punish the raggars if any by conducting an enquiry in terms of the UGC regulations.

Further an Anti-Ragging Squad is constituted consisting of the following under Regulation 26(1) (g) of the UGC act, 1956 to maintain Vigil, Oversight, and patrolling functions and shall always remain mobile active and alert throughout all times to ensure not a single instance of ragging creeps in the college or hostels or anywhere and adopt such measures as may be necessary to curb the menace of ragging.

The squad shall always initiate precautionary measures in visiting all the premises of the college and hostels to avert occurrence ragging in any form or shape. It shall submit a report to the Anti-Ragging Committee about the occurrence of any such incidents immediately.

Note: If the grievances are minor or related to students or parents then they are invited to involve in the redressal mechanism.
