Introduction:-

If everyone develops a sense of love and responsibility towards our college, the idea of cleanliness will naturally take root. Just as we keep our homes clean, if we maintain the cleanliness of our college, streets, and surrounding environment it will contribute to a healthier life for everyone. While the present generation embraces the culture of hard work, there is a need to instill an attitude of maintaining cleanliness among students. It is our foremost duty to actively promote and practice the concepts of cleanliness and hard work among the youth.

In this spirit, the NSS unit of the College organized a “Cleanliness Drive” on the college premises, on 26th October 2024, under the guidance and cooperation of Dr. H.B. Bhuvanewari, the Principal of the college.

Aims:-

The primary objective of this initiative is to instill selfless attitude of “We are here for the society” by emphasizing the importance of volunteer work. It aims to inspire students and foster a positive mindset in their lives.

Description:-

The organization and planing of this cleanliness campaign were led by Shri. Mariswamy N, the NSS Programme Officer of the unit. Addressing the students about the Swachhata Abhiyan program, he emphasized that the idea of cleanliness is to become reality, everyone must strive to keep the college campus as clean as like their own home. He stated that maintaining cleanliness in our surroundings single streets, villages and cities is not solely the responsibility of any organization. Instead it is a collective duty where each individual must contribute. He also highlighted the significant role volunteers play in achieving this goal.

This campaign should not be limited to a single day but should evolve into a continuous effort to maintain cleanliness, he emphasized, adding that development is achievable only when everyone adopts a sense of ownership, thinking, “This is our college, our town and our city”. After introducing the shramdhan task plan to the students, they were divided into 4 teams, each assigned a specific responsibility.

The pile of sand collected for the building’s repair had been scattered along the road, by the rainwater. The first team was assigned the task of gathering it again and placing concrete bricks around the pit and securing the sand to prevent further dispersal. A pile of soil cleared for implementing the rain water harvesting system had accumulated on the walkway. The second team was assigned the task of removing it to ensure smooth traffic flow.

The third team undertook the task of removing garbage and sticks that had accumulated around the plants in the college premises, ensuring the plants were properly cared for. Meanwhile, the fourth team was responsible for maintaining cleanliness by segregating the collected garbage on the campus and disposing of it appropriately.

The college campus was cleaned by the young volunteers through their dedicated hard work throughout the day. Understanding the importance of cleanliness, these young workers developed a strong sense of service. They successfully removed the garbage that had accumulated in the garden, restoring its tidiness.

Conclusion:-

Through this cleanliness campaign, students were able to cultivate an attitude of responsibility towards society by understanding the significance of hard work, voluntary contribution for community welfare, selfless service, determination and a love for environment. They also gained valuable skills and life lessons while fostering a sense of hope and commitment to environmental protection.

All the volunteers actively participated and successfully completed their assigned task. Their efforts were greatly appreciated and as a token of gratitude, cool drinks were distributed to all the participants.
