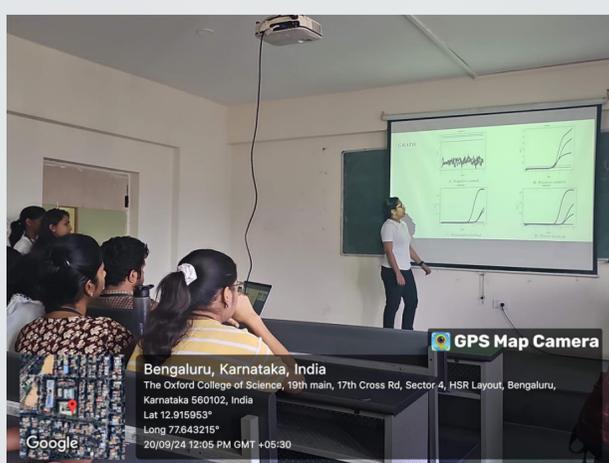


# PROJETHON 2024: A Research Extravaganza

Projethon 2024 was organized by the Research and Development Cell of The Oxford College of Science on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2024. The event aimed to encourage and provide a platform for all the postgraduate students of life science and physical science disciplines to showcase and share their research findings. The day started with an inaugural session with Dr. Anjali Ganjiwale, Department of Life Science, Bangalore University as the chief guest. This was followed by the research presentations. A total of 245 students participated to showcase 133 research projects. The research presentations were conducted in 7 parallel sessions and each judged by two experts in the field. Students from across the disciplines experienced what was truly a day to refine, enrich and expand research. The winners were felicitated at a formal prize distribution ceremony.

# HACKATHON 2024

The *Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC)* under *Research and Development Cell* organized "Hackathon 2024" on *23<sup>rd</sup> August, 2024* at *The Oxford College of Science*. The cell also facilitates networking opportunities with industry leaders and investors, providing a platform for students to showcase their entrepreneurial projects. It plays a crucial role in bridging academic learning with real world entrepreneurship, as well as preparing our students to become future leaders and innovators in the business world.

The HACKATHON-2024 is meticulously designed to foster creativity, collaboration, and innovation. The program also includes networking opportunities, allowing participants to connect with peers and industry professionals. A total of *71 teams, 133 participants*, registered for the event under *Exhibition, Poster Presentation and Model Demo*, with teams consisting of 3-4 participants. The teams had access to mentors who provided guidance and feedback throughout the preparation period. The projects were evaluated by a panel of judges consisting of *Ms Ritasree Sarma, Mr. Abhijit N, and Mrs. Shabina V.A* based on criteria such as innovation, technical complexity, and usability.

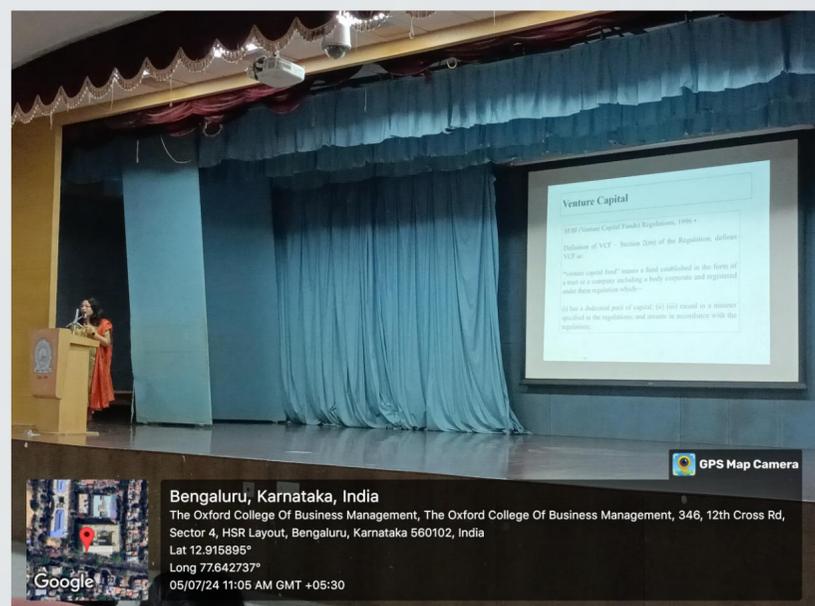
